Anselma

Founded in 1993, Famiglia Anselma is a relatively new Barolo producer. The Anselmas have been acquiring vineyards in Barolo since the seventies and now rank as one of the largest land owners in the region. Despite the modern facilities, Anselma strives for a traditional, long lived style of Barolo. Long fermentations and maturation in exclusively large oak barrels create structured, yet accessible wines with excellent ageing potential. Every wine produced is sourced from a blend of the Anselma's vineyard holdings in the traditional style.

Barale

The Barale family has been making wine in Piemonte since 1870. One of the oldest and most rigorously traditional estates in the area, Barale is one of the few producers who still use large oak casks for fermentation instead of stainless steel. The wines are then matured exclusively in large, old barrels to minimize the apparent flavor of the oak. Barale produces classic, austere nebbiolo that requires many years of ageing to reach full maturity.

Virtually unknown outside of Italy, Castello di Verduno produces a variety of piedmontese wines in a classic style. The Barolo is sourced from the village of Verduno. Known for its sandy soils and generous sun exposure, the Baroli of Verduno are ripe and accessible with less tannic structure.

Cavallotto

Cavallotto Estate has been in the family for five generations and in 1948, the brothers Olivio and Gildo, who were continuing the work of their grandfather Giacomo, their father Giuseppe and their uncle Marcello, became the first people of the area to dedicate themselves to the production and trading of wines. These wines were obtained solely from the grapes of their own vineyards.

A legend among piedmontese producers, Giuseppe Rinaldi has been producing Barolo wine for over a century. As traditional as it gets, "Beppe" Rinaldi still ferments all of his Baroli in the massive, 110 year old piedmontese oak vat that his great grandfather used. The wines are aged in large old oak for two years before bottling. Rinaldi still holds to the tradition of blending fruit from different vineyards to create a perfectly balanced, long aging wine.

Giovanni and Silvano Pasquero-Elia are the inheritors of a winemaking tradition going back 7 generations. The estate, located entirely in Serraboella south and east of Neive, was purchased in 1796 and has been selling wine labeled Barbaresco since 1893. Excellent South- and Southwesterly exposure and natural, low-yield farming consistently has produced classic Piemontese wines.

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Produttori del Barbaresco

Founded in 1958, this landmark co-operative has a sterling reputation for long-aging wines and exceptional value.
